Delegates will be welcomed by the Games Host and his Masked Men to our fully immersive event set up. Teams will take part in 8 fiendish challenges plus the deadly **Red Light, Green Light** Finale

### Hopscotch

....but not as you know it. A combination of the school yard favourite and the shows famous staircase. Designed to disorientate and confuse players it won't be easy as 1,2,3.

### Giant Marbles

Inspired by the 4<sup>th</sup> game from the popular TV series ... just much much bigger.

### Frisbee

Don't be fooled by the name, a gentle game of garden frisbee this is not. Precision is the key, as you goal posts quickly close in on you.

### Tug of War

Pitting teams against each other in the age-old competitive classic, with a twist. Multi-directional tug of war is a guaranteed crowd pleaser ... minus the guillotine and huge fall to death of course.

### Noughts and Crosses

Bringing new life to the paper-based game. Players will be challenged physically with a relay race through an inflatable, and mentally with a giant tic tac toe board.

### Glass Bridges

Teams will sacrifice a member to the deadly arena. Where they will be blindfolded and wear the iconic mask. Armed only with a pool noodle they will need to navigate safely through the arena following careful instruction from their team, in order to eliminate their foe's.
